ORIGIN

*Machaerium Scleroxylon* or *Santos Rosewood* is native of South America. Its color can be highly varied, ranging from reddish/orange to a dark violet/brown, usually with contrasting darker black streaks. Narrow sapwood is a pale yellow and is clearly demarcated from the heartwood.
