ORIGIN

Quercus Alba or *White Oak* is one of the preeminent hardwoods of eastern and central North America. It is very unusual to find an individual specimen with white bark; the usual color is a light gray. The name comes from the color of the finished wood. In the forest it can reach a magnificent height and in the open it develops into a massive broad-topped tree with large branches striking out at wide angles.
